Ross Young Bus Lines

With a new school year starting we would like to remind all drivers to do their part to keep children safe near school buses.

Drivers should follow these tips:

- Stop and never pass a school bus when its red lights are flashing.
- Be prepared to stop for a school bus at any time, not just during school hours.
- Always obey the rules of the road and watch for children, especially in school zones.
- Stop for pedestrians at crosswalks and school crossings.
- Leave space around school buses and avoid blocking the school bus loading/unloading zones so children can enter and exit safely.

Parents can also help keep their children safe by reminding them to be aware of their surroundings when they are on or near a school buses.

School buses are the safest way to get children to and from school, but it's not just bus drivers and students who need to keep safety in mind. We ask all drivers to review the rules to ensure safety throughout the school year. Bus Drivers will do their best to get students to & home from school Safety but we ask all drivers to **STOP for the SCHOOL BUS when the RED are Lights FLASHING!**
